1 WHEREAS, Soror Tanisha Leonard has been serving as 2 Basileus of Lambda Zeta Zeta Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. since 2018; those who have served as Basileus 3 previously are Soror Rosalind Burton from 1981 to 1984; Soror 4 5 Jessie D. Campbell from 1984 to 1986; Soror Eula Thompson from 6 1986 to 1988; Soror Polly Morgan Fitch from 1988 to 1992; 7 Soror Louise B. Chandler from 1992 to 1995; Soror Myra P. 8 Davis from 1995 to 1999; Soror Eula Thompson, for a second time, from 1999 to 2003; Soror Mary D. Thomas from 2003 to 9 10 2008; Soror Glenda McCarroll from 2008 to 2016; and Soror Shelia Cochran from 2016 to 2018; over the decades, the 11 12 chapter has made great progress under the leadership of each 13 Basileus; and
