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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3401.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Institute for the Study of Free Enterprise at Oklahoma State University shall continue at the same location and is hereby designated the School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership at Oklahoma State University. The School of Civic and Economic

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Thought and Leadership shall operate as a single stand-alone academic entity within Oklahoma State University.

- B. The Board of Regents for Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges shall allocate appropriate funding for the operations of the School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership. Funds allocated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to Oklahoma State University and private donations provided for the purpose of supporting the School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership shall be used only for the direct operation of the school and shall not be used for indirect costs of Oklahoma State University.
- C. By October 1, 2024, the School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership at Oklahoma State University shall electronically submit a report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the chairs of the committees with responsibility over higher education in both houses of the Legislature. The report shall include, at a minimum, the following:
  - 1. The total amount of funding received from all sources;
  - 2. A description of faculty positions and courses offered;
  - 3. The total undergraduate and graduate student enrollment; and
  - 4. Significant community events, initiatives, or publications.
- D. The chairs of the committees with responsibility over higher education in both houses of the Legislature may request that the

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    director of the School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership
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    appear before their respective committees to report on the school's
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    annual achievements.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
