### 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 \* Section 1. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 14.30.282. Provision of medically necessary services in a school setting. (a) Each school district shall establish and implement written procedures to allow a child with a disability who has a medical diagnosis and presents a prescription from a qualified health care professional to access medically necessary services in a school setting.
- 9 (b) In this section,
- 10 (1) "health care provider" has the meaning given in AS 08.02.130;
- 11 (2) "qualified health care professional" means a health care provider 12 who is licensed in this state or board certified.
