Establishing a House Special Committee on Arctic Policy, Economic Development, and Tourism.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

**WHEREAS** the strategic location of the state places the state on the forefront of Arctic policy; and

**WHEREAS** economic development is of vital importance to the economy of the state; and

**WHEREAS** tourism is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

**WHEREAS** the legislature should remain well informed about the business climate of the state; and

**WHEREAS** the state must promote business opportunities in the state;

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee on Arctic Policy, Economic Development, and Tourism is established to study tourism, Arctic policy, and opportunities for future economic development of the state's resources; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint

the members and designate a member or members to chair the committee; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Arctic Policy, Economic Development, and Tourism may meet during and between sessions of the Thirty-First Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the First Regular Session of the Thirty-Second Alaska State Legislature.
