**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Authorizing the House of Representatives and the Senate to recess for a period of more**  
2 **than three days.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **WHEREAS** the World Health Organization has declared the novel coronavirus  
5 disease (COVID-19) outbreak a pandemic; and

6 **WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, the Governor declared a statewide public health  
7 disaster emergency to support the response to the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19)  
8 outbreak; and

9 **WHEREAS** art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither  
10 house of the legislature may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other  
11 house concurs; and

12 **WHEREAS** Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that  
13 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house  
14 constitutes concurrence;

15 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of  
16 Representatives may each recess for more than three days during the Second Regular Session

1 of the Thirty-First Alaska State Legislature.
