3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- WHEREAS the World Health Organization has declared the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak a pandemic; and
- J disease (CO v ID-19) outbreak a paridernie, and
- 6 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Governor declared a statewide public health
- 7 disaster emergency to support the response to the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19)
- 8 outbreak; and
- 9 WHEREAS art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither
- 10 house of the legislature may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other
- 11 house concurs; and
- WHEREAS Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that
- adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house
- 14 constitutes concurrence;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of
- Representatives may each recess for more than three days during the Second Regular Session
