A RESOLUTION

1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**
2 **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 278, increasing the base student allocation used**
3 **in the formula for state funding of public education; relating to the exemption from jury**
4 **service for certain teachers; relating to the powers of the Department of Education and**
5 **Early Development; relating to high school course credit earned through assessment;**
6 **relating to school performance reports; relating to assessments; establishing a public**
7 **school and school district grading system; relating to charter schools and student**
8 **transportation; relating to residential school applications; relating to tenure of public**
9 **school teachers; relating to unemployment contributions for the Alaska technical and**
10 **vocational education program; relating to earning high school credit for completion of**
11 **vocational education courses offered by institutions receiving technical and vocational**
12 **education program funding; relating to schools operated by a federal agency; relating to**
13 **a grant for school districts; relating to education tax credits; establishing an optional**

1 **municipal tax exemption for privately owned real property rented or leased for use as a**
2 **charter school; requiring the Department of Administration to provide a proposal for a**
3 **salary and benefits schedule for school districts; and making conforming amendments.**

4 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
6 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
7 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 278, increasing
8 the base student allocation used in the formula for state funding of public education; relating
9 to the exemption from jury service for certain teachers; relating to the powers of the
10 Department of Education and Early Development; relating to high school course credit earned
11 through assessment; relating to school performance reports; relating to assessments;
12 establishing a public school and school district grading system; relating to charter schools and
13 student transportation; relating to residential school applications; relating to tenure of public
14 school teachers; relating to unemployment contributions for the Alaska technical and
15 vocational education program; relating to earning high school credit for completion of
16 vocational education courses offered by institutions receiving technical and vocational
17 education program funding; relating to schools operated by a federal agency; relating to a
18 grant for school districts; relating to education tax credits; establishing an optional municipal
19 tax exemption for privately owned real property rented or leased for use as a charter school;
20 requiring the Department of Administration to provide a proposal for a salary and benefits
21 schedule for school districts; and making conforming amendments.
