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ENROLLED, An Act,

To make a supplemental appropriation from the Alabama Women's Commission Fund to the Alabama Women's Commission in the amount of \$1,493 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013; to make a supplemental appropriation from the Alabama Health Care Trust Fund to the Alabama Medicaid Agency in the amount of \$42,069,180 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013; and to make a supplemental appropriation from the Emergency Forest Fire Fund to the Alabama Forestry Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,493 from the Alabama Women's Commission Fund to the Alabama Women's Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013.

Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$42,069,180 from the Alabama Health Care Trust Fund to the Alabama Medicaid Agency for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$500,000 from the Emergency Forest Fire Fund to the Alabama

2 2013.

3 Section 4. Of the transfer to the Department of
4 Public Health from the State General Fund - CHIP Program in
5 Act 2012-568 of the 2012 Regular Session, the amount of
6 \$1,340,000 shall be reallocated to the Public Health Services
7 Program for the following purposes: \$1,000,000 shall be
8 allocated to the Hudson Alpha Institute to be used for
9 research for cancer, neurodegenerative diseases, and
10 psychiatric disorders; \$140,000 shall be used for
11 UAB-Huntsville in affiliation with local public health care
12 providers to implement a comprehensive screening and health
13 outreach program to include screenings for breast cancer,
14 prostate cancer, diabetes, and other priority conditions, to
15 be implemented through the use of a Mobile Medical Unit and
16 will travel to rural and underserved areas of North Alabama;
17 and \$200,000 shall be used for cystic fibrosis research at the
18 University of South Alabama.

19 Additionally, any earmarking under the Department of
20 Public Health in Act 2012-600 of the 2012 Regular Session for
21 the above purposes shall be void.

22 Section 5. For the fiscal year ending September 30,
23 2013, there shall be transferred from the Departmental
24 Emergency Fund provided for in Section 41-4-94, Code of
25 Alabama, 1975, to the Department of Education for the

1 Catastrophic Special Education Support Allocation an amount of
2 \$100,000.

3 Section 6. This act shall become effective
4 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
5 upon its otherwise becoming law.
