8 Section 1. The following amendment to the 9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become 10 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of 11 this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

13 The Judge of Probate of Houston County shall be an 14 attorney licensed in this state effective upon the election or 15 appointment of any judge of probate after the ratification of 16 the amendment.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.
