Relating to Talladega County; to require volunteer fire departments and any association of volunteer in the county receiving public funds to have an annual audit. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In Talladega County, any volunteer fire 7 8 department in the county that receives public funds and is 9 certified by the Alabama Forestry Commission and any 10 association of volunteer fire departments in the county that 11 receives and disburses public funds shall be audited on an 12 annual basis by an independent certified public accountant not 13 related by blood or marriage to any member of a volunteer fire 14 department. The audit shall be completed within six months of 15 the close of each fiscal year. A copy of the audit shall be 16 filed with the county commission and shall be available for 17 public inspection. The county commission may withhold funds 18 from any entity failing to comply with this act.

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
