BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. The Fairhope Educational Enrichment 6 Foundation, Incorporated, is exempted from paying or 7 collecting any state, county, and municipal sales and use 8 taxes.

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 10 first day of the third month following its passage and 11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
