coroner; to provide for the salary of the coroner effective at

retroactive and curative to January 16, 2023.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 2 and Section 5 of Act 2021-307 of the 2021 Regular Session, are amended to read as follows:

"Section 2.(a) Effective beginning the next term of office of the coroner, 60 days prior to the first day for qualifying in the election for the office of Coroner of Randolph County for the next term of office, the Randolph County Commission may increase and set January 16, 2023, the annual salary of the coroner—for the next term of office at an amount not to exceed shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per month to be paid from the county general fund.

- (b) Effective beginning the next term of office of the coroner commencing in January 2027, and each term thereafter, not less than 60 days prior to the first day for qualifying in the election for the term, the Randolph County Commission may increase and set the annual salary of the coroner commencing on the beginning of that term of office, and thereafter, as determined by the county commission.
- (c) The salaries provided in this section shall be in lieu of any other salary, compensation, fees, or allowances

- 29 provided to the coroner. The coroner shall waive any other
- 30 fees or compensation in order to receive any salary provided

- 32 (d) (1) The Randolph County Commission may authorize the
