Section 1. (a) For purposes of this section, a

private dialysis center is a facility licensed by the

Department of Public Health that provides outpatient renal
dialysis care and is not associated or affiliated with a

licensed hospital.

(b) The Department of Public Health, by rule, shall establish patient to nurse staffing ratios for all private dialysis centers in a manner that protects the health, safety, and welfare of patients, provided the ratio is no greater than eight patients per nurse.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
