HB339 INTRODUCED

- Section 1. Section 16-23-25 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
- \$16-23-25
- 32 (a) A teacher with at least four years of full-time 33 experience as a paraprofessional or classroom teacher's aide 34 in a public school who is: (i) issued a teacher certificate 35 pursuant to this chapter; and (ii) hired into a position 36 requiring such certification, shall receive one year of experience credit on the local teacher salary schedule 37 established pursuant to Section 16-13-231.1 for every two 38 39 years of full-time experience that he or she earned in a public school as a paraprofessional or classroom teacher's 40 41 aide prior to being hired as a certified teacher.
- (b) This section shall only apply to teachers hired into a position requiring teacher certification on or after June 1, 2024.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1, 46 2024.
