4	SYNOPSIS:
5	The Constitution of Alabama of 2022, provides
6	that the salary, fees, or other compensation received
7	by a district attorney during his or her term may not
8	be increased.
9	This bill would propose an amendment to the
10	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide that the
11	salary, fees, or other compensation received by a
12	district attorney may be increased during his or her
13	term.

20	Proposing an amendment to Section 160 of the
21	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to the salary, fees,
22	and other compensation received by a district attorney during
23	his or her term of office.
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
26	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:
27	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
28	Section 160 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is



29 amended to read as follows:

30 "Section 160

31 (a) A district attorney for each judicial circuit shall 32 be elected by the qualified electors of those counties in such 33 the circuit. Such The district attorney shall be licensed to practice law in this state and shall, at the time of his or 34 35 her election and during his or her continuance in office, 36 shall reside in his or her circuit. His The term of office shall be for six years and he. He or she shall receive such 37 compensation as provided by law; provided, the compensation 38 39 shall not be diminished during his or her official term but may be increased. Vacancies in the office of district attorney 40 and in his or her staff shall be filled as provided by law. 41

42 (b) Clerks of the circuit courts shall be elected by 43 the qualified electors in each county for a term of six years. If the office of register in chancery continues to be provided 44 45 by law then the clerk of the circuit court may also fill such 46 the office in a manner prescribed by law. Vacancies in the office of clerk of the circuit court shall be filled by the 47 48 judge or judges of the circuit court who have jurisdiction 49 over the county in which the office of clerk of the circuit 50 court is located.

(c) Persons elected to the position of constable to assist the courts of the state as provided by law shall be subject to the same restrictions, rights, and limitations as are specified in <u>section Section 280</u> of the Constitution of <u>1901Alabama of 2022</u>, and no law shall prohibit the receipt of fees for the performance of official duties of <u>said</u> the

position while holding any other elected or appointed office.
(d) The revenue from fines, forfeitures, and court
costs produced in district courts from the exercise of
jurisdiction under municipal ordinances shall be apportioned
between the municipality and the state as shall be provided by
law."

63 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the 64 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 65 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: 66 67 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest 68 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 69 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize 70 71 language; and translate effective dates.

END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

73 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 74 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 75 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this 76 state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot 77 number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the 78 election ballot and shall set forth the following description 79 of the substance or subject matter of the proposed 80 constitutional amendment:

81 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama 82 of 2022, to provide that the salary of a district attorney may 83 not be diminished but may be increased during his or her term 84 of office.

85 Proposed by Act ."

This description shall be followed by the following language:

88 "Yes() No()."

Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as a part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
