"registered voter" on the license or card of each registered

voter.

- (b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may not impose any charge in addition to the driver's license or nondriver identification card fee for the issuance or renewal of a card for displaying the words registered voter.
- (c) (1) The Secretary of the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency shall adopt the necessary rules for the issuance of drivers' licenses and nondriver identification cards which designate which persons are registered voters.
- (2) The Secretary of State shall cooperate with the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency regarding determinations of valid voter registration.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
