199044-1:n:04/23/2019:JMH/ma LSA2019-775 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 Under existing law, the general and 8 SYNOPSIS: permanent laws of the State of Alabama enacted 9 10 subsequent to the adoption and enactment of the 11 Code of Alabama 1975, including acts of the 1976 12 Regular Session of the Legislature through the 2017 13 Regular Session as contained in the respective 14 annual cumulative supplements and replacement 15 volumes to the code, have been adopted and 16 incorporated in a continuous and systematic manner 17 into the Code of Alabama 1975. 18 This bill would adopt and incorporate into 19 the Code of Alabama 1975, those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during the 2018 20 21 Regular Session as contained in the 2018 Cumulative 22 Supplement to certain volumes of the code and 2018 23 Replacement Volumes 7, 7A, and 12B. 24 This bill would adopt and incorporate into 25 the Code of Alabama 1975, the 2018 supplements to local law volumes. 26

This bill would make certain corrections to 1 2 the replacement volumes and volumes of the 3 cumulative supplement. This bill would specify that this adoption 4 5 and incorporation constitutes a continuous systematic codification of the entire Code of 6 7 Alabama 1975, and would expressly provide that this act does not affect 2019 session statutes. 8 This bill would also specify the duties of 9 10 the Secretary of State regarding the custody of these cumulative supplements and replacement 11 volumes. 12 13 14 A BILL 15 TO BE ENTITLED 16 AN ACT 17 18 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 19 1975, those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during the 2018 Regular Session as contained in the 2018 20 21 Cumulative Supplement to certain volumes of the code and 2018

during the 2018 Regular Session as contained in the 2018 Cumulative Supplement to certain volumes of the code and 2018 Replacement Volumes 7, 7A, and 12B; to adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, 2018 Cumulative Supplements to local law volumes; to make certain corrections in the replacement volumes and certain volumes of the cumulative supplement; to specify that this adoption and incorporation constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire 1 Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law that adopts a 2 code; to declare that the Code Publisher has certified it has 3 discharged its duties regarding the replacement volumes; to 4 expressly provide that this act does not affect any 2019 5 session statutes; and to specify the duties of the Secretary 6 of State regarding the custody of these cumulative supplements 7 and replacement volumes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. (a) Those general and permanent laws of 10 the state enacted during the 2018 Regular Session as contained in the 2018 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to 6B, 11 inclusive, Volumes 8 to 12A, inclusive, Volumes 13 to 22A, 12 13 inclusive, and the 2018 Replacement Volumes 7, 7A, and 12B, and the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner 14 15 for editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2018 16 17 Cumulative Supplement and 2018 Replacement Volumes are 18 identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of the volumes 19 20 of the cumulative supplements and upon the first inside page 21 and the last inside page of the replacement volumes, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975. 22

10 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state previously enacted and contained in the local and 11 12 permanent laws pertaining to various counties enacted during 13 the 2018 Regular Session as contained in the 2018 Cumulative 14 Supplement to Volumes 22B, 22C, 22D, 22E, 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I, 15 22J, and 22K, and the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published 16 by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of 17 18 the 2018 Cumulative Supplement are identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed 19 20 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the 21 cumulative supplement, are adopted and incorporated into the 22 Code of Alabama 1975.

23 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the 24 supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act 25 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the 26 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the 27 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. This act is a law that adopts a code for the purposes of Section 45 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this act shall be deemed to codify any provision of law that was adopted in violation of any provision of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, establishing requirements for, or limitations on, the enactment of a law.

8 Section 4. It is declared that Thomson Reuters, as 9 the Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its 10 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2018 Replacement Volumes 7, 7A, and 12B of the Code of Alabama 11 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes 12 13 with the material contained in the cumulative supplement 14 without making substantive changes, but making, under the 15 supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code 16 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may 17 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of 18 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and 19 20 misspellings.

21 Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not 22 repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any 23 statute enacted into law during any 2019 session of the 24 Legislature.

25 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act, 26 the duly authenticated volumes of the 2018 Cumulative 27 Supplements and the 2018 Replacement Volumes shall be

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transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the 1 2 volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in that 3 office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement volumes shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary of 4 State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper 5 certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or 6 7 parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for similar services. 8

9 Section 7. This act shall become effective 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the 11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
