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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Sumter County; authorizing the sheriff to operate a jail store for prisoners in county custody; providing for the deposit, distribution, and auditing of monies earned; and confirming and ratifying certain prior actions.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. The Sheriff of Sumter County or the 10 authorized agents of the sheriff may operate a jail store for 11 prisoners within the confines of the county jail. The jail 12 store shall be operated to serve the needs of the jail 13 population.

14 Section 2. (a) The sheriff shall establish and 15 maintain a Law Enforcement Fund in a bank located in Sumter 16 County. All proceeds collected under this act shall be tax 17 exempt and deposited by the sheriff into the Sheriff's Law 18 Enforcement Fund. All jail store transactions shall be 19 accounted for in the fund.

(b) The sheriff shall keep an account of all jail
store sales and transactions of the Sheriff's Law Enforcement
Fund for audit by the Department of Examiners of Public
Accounts. The jail store account and Sheriff's Law Enforcement
Fund shall be audited at the same time other accounts of the
sheriff are audited. The Department of Examiners of Public

Accounts shall submit a copy of the audit to the sheriff
 within 30 days of its completion.

3 Section 3. All profits realized in the operation of 4 the jail store shall be expended at the discretion of the 5 sheriff for law enforcement purposes in Sumter County that are 6 in the interest of the public.

Section 4. The establishment of the Sheriff's Law
Enforcement Fund and the use of the proceeds shall not
diminish or take the place of any other source of income
established for the sheriff or the operation of the office.

11 Section 5. Any actions relating to the operation of 12 a jail store in the county jail prior to the effective date of 13 this act are ratified and confirmed. Any existing proceeds 14 derived from the operation of a jail store in the county jail 15 prior to the effective date of this act shall be deposited 16 into the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund created by this act.

17 Section 6. This act shall become effective 18 immediately following its passage and approval by the 19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
