| 17 | which prohibits the use of federal funds for abortions; and    |
| 18 | WHEREAS, the Biden Administration has issued an                |
| 19 | Executive Order repealing the Global Protect Life Policy,      |
| 20 | formerly the Mexico City Policy, which precludes the use of    |
| 21 | federal funds to pay for overseas abortions through various    |
| 22 | federal funding programs; and                                  |
| 23 | WHEREAS, the Biden Administration has instructed the           |
| 24 | Department of Health and Human Services to begin the process   |
| 25 | to change regulations to overturn the Protect Life Rule, which |
| 26 | protects taxpayers from publicly funding abortion businesses   |
| 27 | through the Title X program; and                               |

| 10 | WHEREAS, by Executive Order, the Trump                         |
| 11 | Administration restored the Global Protect Life Policy,        |

| 14 | WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services           |
| 15 | passed regulations, the Protect Life Rule, to prohibit the use |

WHEREAS, 77 percent of Americans oppose using taxpayer dollars for abortions overseas and 58 percent of Americans oppose using taxpayer dollars to fund abortions in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has a strong public policy against abortion having enacted Article I, Section 36.06, of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, recognizing the sanctity of unborn life and its protection under all laws, and having enacted the Alabama Human Life Protection Act, Section 26-23H-1, et seq., Code of Alabama 1975, which prohibits abortion; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama opposes any use of taxpayer funds on both the federal and state levels for the funding of abortion or abortion businesses; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we oppose the repeal of the Hyde Amendment and encourage the U.S. Congress to maintain its policy against the federal funding of abortions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we oppose Health and Human Services' administrative action to repeal the Protect Life Rule that will permit the funding of abortions through Title X programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we encourage the U.S. Congress to address the Biden Administration's Executive Order repealing the Global Protect Life Policy, formerly known as the Mexico City Policy, by enacting legislation that prohibits the use of American tax dollars to fund abortions overseas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the U.S. Congress take
all further and different action as shall be appropriate and
necessary for the protection of unborn life in America.
