3 COMMENDING JANET MANN FOR SERVICE TO THE MONTGOMERY
4 TUSKEGEE ALUMNI CLUB.

6 WHEREAS, it is with pleasure that we commend Janet
7 Mann for service as a member and President of the Montgomery
8 Tuskegee Alumni Club; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mann is a 1973 Business Management
10 graduate of Tuskegee University; in 1978, she became a member
11 of the Montgomery Tuskegee Alumni Club and became the chair of
12 the Ways and Means Committee; due to her ingenuity, she was
13 given the task of developing fundraising and entertainment for
14 the club; as a result of setting up a "Putting on the Hits"
15 contest, working with local DJs and radio personalities, the
16 membership of the club began to increase; in 1985, she was
17 elected as vice president and served two terms and became
18 active with the Tuskegee Alumni Southeast Region and the
19 Tuskegee National Alumni Association; and

20 WHEREAS, in 1989, Mrs. Mann was elected president of
21 the Montgomery Tuskegee Alumni Club and has served in that
22 position for 30 years; during her tenure she has achieved many
23 firsts, some of which include the MTAC newsletter, a
24 fundraiser featuring a New York Broadway Play at the Davis
25 Theater, MTAC homecoming fundraiser, Turkey Day alumni

1 reception, bus trips for sporting events, and created an MTAC
2 t-shirt, and souvenir ad journal for banquets; and many other
3 innovative programs for the club; and

4 WHEREAS, in 1998, she was elected as Tuskegee Alumni
5 Southeast Region Director and served in that position until
6 2003; she instituted many cutting edge programs and was
7 instrumental in getting the region to establish an emergency
8 fund for Southeast Region students; during her tenure as SER
9 Director seven clubs were established or reactivated; she was
10 very active in the club and accomplished many goals; she led
11 the local club to new heights with its annual fundraiser; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mann never lets anything deter her
13 from being actively involved in working with the club, going
14 out on recruiting events, attending conferences or
15 volunteering to work with regional and national events; due to
16 her tenacity, the club has increased its membership and
17 continues to raise monies for the scholarship fund; during her
18 tenure as president, over 100 scholarships were awarded to
19 local area students; she has received many awards and
20 accolades for her dedication and hard work with Tuskegee,
21 TNAA, SER, and MTAC; now therefore,
