7 service to the Legislature of Alabama since 1991; he holds the
8 distinction as being the longest serving Director of
9 Legislative Reference Service from 1991 until 2015; he
10 continues to serve the Legislature as Senior Counsel to the
11 Legislative Services Agency; and

12 WHEREAS, after working with the Legislature of
13 California in a similar capacity, Mr. Bassett relocated to
14 Alabama to share his knowledge, expertise, and leadership with
15 the Legislature of Alabama; representing Alabama in an
16 exceptional manner, Mr. Bassett became a true Alabamian and
17 served professionally with numerous legal and bill drafting
18 organizations, including the Style Committee of the Uniform
19 Commission on State Laws, The Council of State Governments,
20 National Conference of State Legislatures, and the Southern
21 Legislative Conference; and

22 WHEREAS, during his years of service to the
23 Legislature of Alabama, Jerry Bassett served in leadership
24 roles and shepherded numerous legislators, staff, and the
