3 COMMENDING CALHOUN COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTY TYLER
4 PECK AS A NOMINEE FOR THE 2019 ALABAMA LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF
5 HONOR FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

7 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
8 recognize Calhoun County Sheriff's Deputy Tyler Peck as a
9 nominee for the 2019 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor for
10 Law Enforcement, Alabama's highest law enforcement award for
11 extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

12 WHEREAS, on August 17, 2018, at about 9:50 PM,
13 Deputy Peck arrived on the scene of a shots fired call; the
14 residents informed Deputy Peck that they heard multiple gun
15 shots fired from behind their residence; the deputy instructed
16 the callers to remain inside and he began a search of the
17 property; he located the victim and found him severely
18 wounded, but conscious; the victim told Deputy Peck that he
19 did not know if the shooter was still on the scene, but he had
20 returned gunfire with his shotgun; Deputy Peck called for
21 backup and EMS; he then applied a life-saving tourniquet to
22 the victim's leg; despite their exposed position and the
23 reduced visibility caused by rain and darkness, Deputy Peck
24 continued to apply lifesaving measures to the victim until
25 back up arrived; as a result of the quick action taken by

1 Deputy Peck, the victim survived his wounds; Deputy Peck is 22
2 years old and had recently completed his field training; and

3 WHEREAS, Deputy Tyler Peck demonstrated immense
4 courage, diligence, and quick response in a life-threatening
5 situation; his loyalty and unwavering commitment to protect
6 and serve the residents of Calhoun County were evidenced
7 through his willingness to make the quick and proper response
8 in order to protect the lives of others; and

9 WHEREAS, Deputy Peck epitomizes the qualities of
10 those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this
11 distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor
12 for Law Enforcement; now therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
14 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize and honor
15 Calhoun County Sheriff's Deputy Tyler Peck as a nominee for
16 the 2019 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement and
17 direct that he receive a copy of this resolution as evidence
18 of our admiration and esteem.
