WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson has always worked hard and taken pride in his obligations, and he has successfully withstood many obstacles; also, he loves God and dedicates his life to Him; when he talks to the Lord, he loves to proclaim, "Don't ever leave me out of whatever You are doing"; now therefore,
