11	WHEREAS, the March of Dimes leads the fight for the
12	health of all mothers and babies by supporting research,

17	prematurely each year; and
18	WHEREAS, Alabama is one of only four states that
19	received a grade of "F" on the March of Dimes 2018 Premature
20	Birth Report Card; and
21	WHEREAS, the preterm birth rate among black women is
22	51 percent higher than other races in Alabama; and
23	WHEREAS, women of color are most at risk of facing
24	birth complications; black women are three to four times more
25	likely to die from complications related to pregnancy compared
26	to white women; and this disparity exists regardless of
27	education or income level; and

1 WHEREAS, according to the March of Dimes report,
2 "Nowhere to Go," 19 counties in Alabama were identified as
3 maternal care deserts, where women lack access to maternity
4 care services; and

WHEREAS, access to health insurance coverage through Medicaid expansion and the filling of coverage gaps is integral to people's ability to obtain necessary health care services including preconception, prenatal, maternity, postpartum, and interconception care, the care necessary to reduce the incidence of preterm birth, and lead productive lives; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we recognize Sunday, May 12, 2019, as March of Dimes Day, as a day to honor mothers and resolve to work with the March of Dimes and its partners to continue to support and encourage innovative policies and solutions that address the persistent disparities in health care access and outcomes in order to assure healthy mothers and strong babies; a copy of this resolution shall be provided for appropriate presentation and display.
