7 WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein presented  
8 to Ms. Michelle Head who will be honored by the Willie A. and  
9 Betty C. Farrior Family Foundation during its Leadership  
10 Luncheon on Saturday, March 23, 2019, in the Talladega  
11 Regional Family Life Center for her Outstanding Service to the  
12 Talladega Community and the State of Alabama; and

13 WHEREAS, the Willie A. and Betty C. Farrior Family  
14 Foundation is a nonprofit organization established March 2017,  
15 by Colonel (Retired) Cedrick A. Farrior in memory of Mr. and  
16 Mrs. Farrior; both were native Alabamians who unfortunately  
17 lost their vision at an early age; they attended the Alabama  
18 School for the Negro Blind in Talladega, Alabama; they were  
19 married in October 1945; Willie was the first Black blind  
20 individual to be employed at the Alabama Industries for the  
21 Blind in June 1950; Willie retired from AIDB after completion  
22 of 40 years of employment; Betty retired after completion of  
23 27 years of employment; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Michelle Head is currently the  
25 principal of Stemley Road Elementary School; she is completing  
26 her 26th year in education with 13 years in Talladega County;  
27 Ms. Head graduated from Winterboro High School and the

1 University of Montevallo with an Educational Specialist Degree  
2 in 2001; she relocated from Shelby County to her roots in  
3 hopes of serving her community, especially the children; and

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Head states, "We must all honor  
5 childhood, protect children from barriers and provide support  
6 to schools"; she is a believer in the power of community based  
7 partnerships; as a member of Alpine Baptist Church, she sees  
8 the benefits when schools are supported through a strong  
9 volunteer program; she believes that, "When we work as one,  
10 the children are better prepared for the future; now  
11 therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF  
13 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we heartily congratulate Ms.  
14 Michelle Head on being honored by the Willie A. and Betty C.
