HIGGINS, TROY 8 9 UNIVERSITY'S VICE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE BOARD OF 10 TRUSTEES. 11 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the 12 13 death on April 15, 2021, of Mr. Lamar P. Higgins, Troy 14 University's Vice President Pro Tempore of the Board of 15 Trustees, at the age of 61; and 16 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of 17 his loving family, many friends, and the entire community, 18 where he was highly regarded; and WHEREAS, a native of Marbury, Alabama, Mr. Higgins 19 20 was Troy University's first black Student Government 21 Association President and first black Trustee, serving on the 22 university's Board of Trustees for the past 25 years; in March 23 2021, he was honored at Troy University's second annual Unity 24 Prayer Breakfast, where Chancellor Jack Hawkins, Jr. announced 25 that the newly renovated ballrooms at the Trojan Student Center would bear Higgins's name; he was also a partner at 26

Fine Geddie and Associates, a prominent Montgomery-based
lobbying firm, where he served for 26 years; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Higgins first served on the Troy 4 University Board of Trustees in the late 1970s as a student 5 representative during his junior and senior years; he became 6 the first black member of the university's Board of Trustees 7 in 1996; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Higgins' caring heart and his steadfast 8 9 commitment to serving others inspired many during his 10 lifetime; some of his incredible achievements include serving as a key figure in establishing the Rosa Parks Museum and the 11 John Robert Lewis Leadership Conference and in initiating the 12 13 African American Leadership Conference; serving the U.S. Space and Rocket Center in Huntsville, Alabama, as Assistant to the 14 15 Director and Assistant Director for Human Resources; serving as the Equal Employment Officer for the City of Huntsville; 16 17 serving as Assistant Director of the Alabama Department of 18 Economic and Community Affairs, where he supervised the department's 11 divisions and guided millions of dollars in 19 20 federal grant money to cities, counties, and corporations 21 across the state; serving as Special Assistant to the Mayor of 22 Huntsville; serving on Senator Howell Heflin's staff; and 23 serving as Deputy Director of the Alabama Department of 24 Economic and Community Affairs; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Higgins once stated, "I've been really 26 fortunate to be able to come to Troy University, get a great 27 education, and be able to come back and try to give back to

the university and to the community for the things that I've been fortunate enough to participate in and go through because of Troy University"; and

WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly missed, the memory of Mr. Higgins will be cherished in the hearts of all who knew and loved him; the beautiful legacy that he created will indeed continue; now therefore,
