POSTHUMOUSLY COMMENDING MOBILE POLICE OFFICER JUSTIN

BILLA AS A RECIPIENT OF THE 2019 ALABAMA LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF

HONOR FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we recognize Deputy Justin Billa as a recipient of the 2019

Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement,

Alabama's highest law enforcement award for extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2018, Deputy Justin Billa tragically lost his life while responding to a crime at the Ridge Road West area in Mobile, Alabama, where Deputy Billa and other police found a female body, identified as Fonda Poellnitz; through continued investigation, detectives followed up on the whereabouts of Poellnitz's ex-husband, Robert Hollie; police responded to Hollie's residence and observed a vehicle that belonged to Hollie in the driveway; while waiting for additional officers to set up perimeter, Hollie emerged and fired multiple shots, with one round striking Officer Billa; Officer Billa was immediately removed

from the scene and transported to the hospital, where he later 1 2 died; soon thereafter, SWAT members found Hollie deceased inside the residence from a self-inflicted gunshot wound; and 3 WHEREAS, Deputy Billa will be remembered for his 5 immense bravery and his unwavering commitment to protect and serve others; he is truly deserving as a recipient of the 2019 7 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we hereby posthumously 9 10 recognize and honor Mobile Police Officer Justin Billa for his courage and as a recipient of the 2019 Legislative Medal of 11 Honor of Law Enforcement; we dedicate this resolution to him 12 13 in utmost gratitude, admiration, and esteem.
