11 the death of Mr. John Quarles, Jr., of Northport, Alabama, on  
12 March 20, 2013, at the age of 71 years; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of  
14 his loving family and his many friends; he was a former  
15 Northport City Councilman and enjoyed a distinguished career  
16 in banking; and

17 WHEREAS, a native of Northport, he was a 1960  
18 graduate of Tuscaloosa County High School and earned both  
19 Bachelor's and Master's Degrees from The University of  
20 Alabama; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Quarles served with dedication on the  
22 Northport City Council in the late 1970s and early 1980s and  
23 later served on the Northport Planning and Zoning Commission;

25 WHEREAS, he initially was employed as vice president  
26 and treasurer of First Federal Savings and Loan and later

1 served as vice president and trust officer for Regions Bank in  
2 Tuscaloosa; and

3 WHEREAS, survivors include his wife, Gail Roberts  
4 Quarles; son, John Andrew Quarles; daughter, Lillian Quarles  
5 Turman; and five grandchildren; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Quarles was a valued member of the  
7 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his  
8 memory will be cherished in the hearts of those who were  
9 fortunate to know him; now therefore,
