1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
4 existence and functioning of the Board of Heating, Air
5 Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors until October 1,
6 2028.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
9 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of
10 Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors until
11 October 1, 2028.

12 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Board
13 of Heating, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors,
14 created and functioning pursuant to Chapter 31 of Title 34,
15 Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections
16 are expressly preserved.

17 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
18 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
19 Sections 1 and 2.

20 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
21 2024.
