4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to immunity of magistrates and clerks; to
6 provide absolute judicial immunity to every magistrate and
7 clerk of the circuit and district courts of this state under
8 certain conditions.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. In the performance of any duties provided
11 for by Sections 12-17-94(a) and 12-17-251(c), Code of Alabama
12 1975, every magistrate and clerk of the circuit and district
13 courts of this state shall have absolute judicial immunity
14 from any liability arising from the execution of the duties
15 provided for by Sections 12-17-94(a) and 12-17-251(c), Code of
16 Alabama 1975.

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
