8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, each distinctive license  
9 plate issued is required to have an additional fee  
10 of \$50. Five dollars of the fee is deposited in the  
11 Penny Trust Fund.

12 This bill would provide that this \$5 of the  
13 fee would be deposited in the Senior Services Trust  
14 Fund.

17 TO BE ENTITLED  
18 AN ACT

20 To amend Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama  
21 1975, providing for an additional fee for the issuance of  
22 distinctive license plates, to further provide for the  
23 distribution of the fee.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama  
26 1975, is amended to read as follows:

27 "§32-6-68.

1           "(a) Effective January 1, 1997, each new distinctive  
2 license plate issued shall require, in addition to the  
3 standard registration fee, an additional annual fee of fifty  
4 dollars (\$50).

5           "(b) The additional license plate fee as provided  
6 for in subsection (a) shall be distributed in the following  
7 manner:

8           "(1) Two and one-half percent commission, provided  
9 by Section 40-12-269(a) (1).

10           "(2) Manufacturing costs of one dollar and fifty  
11 cents (\$1.50) to the Department of Corrections.

12           "(3) Administrative costs of one dollar (\$1) to the  
13 Department of Revenue.

14           "(4) ~~State shares~~ A state share of five dollars (\$5)  
15 shall be transmitted to the state Comptroller for deposit into  
16 the ~~Penny Senior Services~~ Trust Fund as established by  
17 ~~Amendment 512 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901~~ in  
18 Section 38-3-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975.

19           "(5) The remainder of the additional fee shall be  
20 distributed to the sponsoring organization or as otherwise  
21 provided under the terms of the application approved by the  
22 legislative oversight committee.

23           "(c) The distribution of fees for tags which were  
24 authorized by legislative act before January 1, 1998, shall  
25 continue in effect, any other provision of law to the contrary  
26 notwithstanding."

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
2           first day of the third month following its passage and  
3           approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
