members to the Alabama Commission on Elementary and Secondary 1 2 Education as provided by the Constitution of Alabama of 1901. 3 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the 4 5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law, contingent on the ratification of a constitutional amendment proposed during the 7 2019 Regular Session, renaming the State Board of Education as the Alabama Commission on Elementary and Secondary Education 8 and providing for the appointment of the members of the 9
