Section 1. The following amendment to the
 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
 this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

(a) The Legislature finds and declares that based 6 7 upon the history of the times, the existing order of things, the state of the law when Amendment 744 to the Constitution of 8 Alabama of 1901, was adopted, and the conditions necessitating 9 10 its adoption, the voters in Macon County intended to and did authorize the Sheriff of Macon County to adopt rules for the 11 12 licensing and operation of bingo games in Macon County, 13 Alabama, including bingo games to be played on paper, machine, or electronic devices. 14

15 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 65 of this Constitution, for the purpose of Amendment 744 to the 16 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, the game of bingo authorized 17 18 to be played in Macon County by Amendment 744 may be played on any electronic machine. Sections 8-1-150, 13A-12-20, 19 20 13A-12-21, 13A-12-22, 13A-12-23, 13A-12-24, 13A-12-25, 21 13A-12-26, 13A-12-27, and 13A-12-30 of the Code of Alabama 1975, shall not apply to any bingo game authorized by this 22 23 amendment and operated in accordance with the rules adopted by 24 the Sheriff of Macon County.

(c) For purposes of this amendment, bingo means a
specific kind of game of chance commonly known as bingo,
whether or not played using paper or on a computer or using

1 electronic or technological aids in connection therewith, in 2 which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated numbers or symbols on a card conforming to numbers or symbols selected at 3 random. The game of bingo may be played on any machine or 4 5 device, electronic or otherwise. Sections 8-1-150, 13A-12-20 6 through 13A-12-30 of the Code of Alabama 1975, do not apply to 7 any bingo games authorized by this amendment and operated in 8 accordance with the rules adopted by the Sheriff of Macon 9 County.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 11 shall be held at the March 2020 primary election in accordance 12 with Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 13 now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation 14 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the 15 election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

21 "Relating to Macon County, proposing an amendment to 22 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the game 23 of bingo authorized in Macon County by Amendment 744 to the 24 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, may be played on any 25 electronic machine.
