10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the Town of Akron in Hale County.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
17 of the Town of Akron in Hale County are altered, rearranged,
18 and extended to include within the corporate limits of the
19 municipality, in addition to the lands now included, all of
20 the following territory:

21 Legal description of property for the purpose of
22 Annexation to the Town of Akron, said property lying in
23 Section 13, and Section 24, in Township 22 North, Range 3
24 East, also all of Section 18, a part of Section 17, a part of
25 Section 20 and a part of Section 19, all in Township 22 North,
26 Range 4 East, Hale County, Alabama, being more particularly
27 described as follows:

1 BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of Section 18;
2 thence run East along the North boundary line of Section 18 to
3 the Northeast corner of said Section; thence run South along
4 the East boundary of said Section a distance of 1327.0' feet
5 more or less; thence run East along the South margin of Clary
6 Loop Road a distance of 1393.0' feet more or less to a point;
7 thence run South along the West margin of Clary Loop Road for
8 600.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run East along the
9 South margin of Clary Loop road a distance of 780.0' feet more
10 or less to a point; thence run South for a distance 680.0'
11 feet more or less to a point; thence run East a distance of
12 470.0' feet more or less to a point on the East boundary line
13 of the West Half of Section 17; thence run South along the
14 East boundary of the West Half of Section 17, to a point on
15 the South boundary line of Section 17; thence run East a
16 distance of 1037.0' feet more or less to a point where said
17 Section line intersects a branch known as Muddy Branch; thence
18 run Southeasterly along said meandering branch to its
19 intersection of the South boundary line of the North Half of
20 Section 20 and the East boundary line of Section 20; thence
21 run South along the East boundary line of Section 20 a
22 distance of 980.0' feet more or less to the North margin of
23 Hale County Road No. 42 also known as Wedgeworth Long Bridge
24 Road; thence run Northwesterly along the North margin of said
25 road a distance of 1500' feet more or less; thence run North
26 564.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run West a
27 distance of 1957.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run

1 South a distance of 1320' feet more or less to a point; thence
2 run West for 672.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run
3 South 163.0' feet more or less; thence run West for 1311.0'
4 feet more or less to a point on the East boundary line of
5 Section 19; thence run South 1115.0' feet more or less to the
6 Southeast corner of Section 19, Township 22 North, Range 4
7 East; thence run West along the South boundary line of Section
8 19 for 3941.0' feet more or less to its intersection with the
9 East margin of Alabama State Highway No. 60; thence run
10 Northeasterly along the East margin of said State Road for
11 1867.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run West a
12 distance of 1930.0' feet to a point on the West boundary line
13 of Section 19; thence run South along the West boundary line
14 of Section 19 for a distance of 374.0' feet more or less to a
15 point; thence run West a distance of 1320.0' feet more or less
16 to a point; thence run North a distance of 3974.0' feet more
17 or less to a point; thence run Northwesterly a distance of
18 1227.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run Northeasterly
19 a distance of 312.0' feet more or less to a point; thence run
20 North a distance of 1482.0' feet more or less to a point;
21 thence run East a distance of 1820.0' feet to a point on the
22 West boundary line of Section 18; thence run North along the
23 West boundary line of Section 18 for 2640.0' feet more or less
24 to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

25 The above described property contains 2,030.00 Acres
26 more or less.

1 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
2 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
3 proposed to be annexed to the Town of Akron is on file in the
4 office of the Judge of Probate in Hale County, Alabama, and
5 the map is open to the inspection of the public.

6 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
