In the event of a ten percent (10%) increase in 6 utility rates and fuel rates, the Department of Correction is authorized to 7 transfer any line item appropriation in this Act to the Maintenance and 8 Operation line item for support of the increase after receiving approval of 9 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
