The State Military Department is 14 hereby authorized to stock various State Military Lakes on Camp Robinson post 15 each year with fish for special events by using wildlife funds and rental 16 income, no State General Revenue will be used.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, <del>2018</del> 18 <u>2019</u> through June 30, <del>2019</del> <u>2020</u>.

20 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GENERALS 22 SALARY. The line item maximums for the State of Arkansas Adjutant General and 23 Deputy Adjutant General are based on the salary grid by the United States 24 Department of Defense. Incumbents in these positions shall be compensated in 25 accordance with the Department of Defense Advisory Service Pay Plan and are 26 not guaranteed placement at the maximum level. The line item maximum 27 salaries may be adjusted on July 1 of each fiscal year to incorporate salary 28 rate changes that have been implemented by the U.S. Department of Defense. 29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018 30 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 <u>PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The State Military Department is hereby authorized to</u>

7 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25

26 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 31 32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
