11 ASSEMBLY AT LEAST NINETY DAYS BEFORE THE NEW FEE OR
12 CHANGED FEE IS IMPOSED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 TO REQUIRE A STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION
16 OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO REPORT ANY NEW
17 FEES OR CHANGES TO EXISTING FEES CHARGED

19 LEAST NINETY DAYS BEFORE THE NEW FEE OR

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-61-215 is amended to read as follows:
27 6-61-215. Student fees.

28 (a)(1) In order to promote a coordinated system of higher education in
29 Arkansas and to assure an orderly and effective development of each ~~of the~~
30 ~~publicly supported institutions~~ state-supported institution of higher
31 education, the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board ~~shall have the~~
32 ~~power and duty to~~ may establish the level of student fees for funding
33 purposes for both in-state and out-of-state students for all ~~public~~
34 ~~institutions of higher learning in the state~~ state-supported institutions of
35 higher education.

36 (2) The level of fees shall be determined after careful study of



1 fees charged in other states in similar institutions.

2 (b) At least ninety (90) days before a state-supported institution of
3 higher education imposes a new fee or changes an existing fee charged to
4 students, the state-supported institution of higher education shall notify
5 the Legislative Council of the:

6 (1) Amount of the new fee or change to existing fee; and

7 (2) Rationale behind adopting a new fee or changing an existing
8 fee.
