22	of "salary" and other definitions that apply to the Arkansas Teacher		
23	Retirement System, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as

28	SECTION 2. EME	RGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determ	nined by the
29	General Assembly of t	the State of Arkansas that certain prov	risions of the
30	Arkansas Teacher Reti	rement System Act, an act that created	l a state agency
31	for the purpose of pr	coviding retirement benefits to school	employees of the
32	state, are in need of	revision and updating to maintain the	e teacher
33	retirement laws in co	onformance with sound public pension po	olicy; that the
34	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a fiscal year of July 1 to		
35	June 30; that a July	1, 2019 effective date is necessary to	o allow the
36	provisions within thi	s act to begin on the first day of the	e fiscal year to

1	provide proper administration of the procedures referenced in this act; that
2	the updates and revisions to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are
3	of great importance for actuarial purposes and the protection of member
4	benefits under the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System; and that this act is
5	necessary in order to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members
6	of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is
7	declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
8	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2019.
