17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-42-115 is amended to read as follows:
20	14-42-115. Volunteer <u>Unpaid</u> firefighter or volunteer <u>unpaid</u> police
21	officer on governing body.
22	(a)(l) It is lawful for a volunteer <u>an unpaid</u> firefighter or a
23	volunteer an unpaid police officer in any city of the first class, city of
24	the second class, or incorporated town in this state to seek election to, and
25	if elected, to serve as a member of the city council or other governing body
26	of the city or town.
27	(2) This service shall not be deemed a conflict of interest and
28	shall not be prohibited by the civil service regulations of any city or town.
29	(b) A person may serve and receive compensation as a member of the
30	governing body of any city of the first class, city of the second class, or
31	incorporated town and simultaneously serve as a volunteer firefighter or a
32	<i>volunteer police officer and receive compensation as a firefighter or a</i>
33	police officer.
34 35	(c) The provisions of this section shall not apply after August 13,
35 36	1993, to any city having a city administrator form of government.
