25	SECTION 1. Arka	ansas Code § 21-11-103 is amended to	read as follows:	
26	21-11-103. Emplo	oyee Suggestion <u>Team Arkansas</u> System	established.	
27	There is establi	shed a program to be known as the $\frac{Em}{2}$	ployee Suggestion	
28	<u>Team Arkansas</u> System t	to encourage the development of ideas	for improving the	
29	economy and efficiency of state government, to grant awards for ideas of			
30	proper merit, and to i	implement them in the governmental pr	ocess.

32	SECTION 2. Arka	ansas Code § 21-11-104 is amended to	read as follows:	
33	21-11-104. Rule	es and regulations — Procedure for su	bmission of	
34	suggestions - Rejection or acceptance of employee suggestion.			
35	(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration, or			
36	his or her designee , i	is directed to develop and adopt rule	s and regulations	

1	in accordance with this chapter for the administration of the Employee
2	Suggestion System.
3	(b)(1) The rules shall provide for the direct submission of all
4	suggestions to the Office of Personnel Management's Employee Suggestion
5	System for determination of eligibility under the rules and regulations as
6	authorized in this section.
7	(2) Eligible suggestions will be forwarded to the department
8	director, or to the department director's designated representative, for
9	evaluation of proper merit.
10	(b)(1) An employee suggestion shall be made in writing to the head of
11	the state agency that is the employer of the employee or group of employees
12	making the employee suggestion.
13	(2) To be eligible for an award made under this chapter, a
14	employee or a group of employees must propose a change that is not currently
15	under active consideration by the state agency or the Suggestion Award Board.
16	(3) If a duplicate employee suggestion is submitted, only the
17	employee or group of employees who makes the first employee suggestion
18	received is eligible for an award made under this chapter.
19	(c) Upon receiving an employee suggestion under subsection (b) of this
20	section, a head of a state agency shall:
21	(1) Record and acknowledge receipt of the employee suggestion;
22	(2) Notify the employee or each employee in the group of
23	employees who made the employee suggestion of any undue delays in the
24	consideration of the employee suggestion; and
25	(3) Notify the board of the employee suggestion.
26	(d) If an employee suggestion is:
27	(1) Rejected by a state agency, the head of the state agency
28	shall notify the board and the employee or each employee in the group of
29	employees who made the employee suggestion of the rejection and the reason

 34 projected reduction, elimination, or avoidance of expenditures or improvement

3	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 21-11-105 is amended to read as follows:		
4	21-11-105. Suggestion Team Arkansas Award Board — Review of agency		
5	decision.		
6	(a)(1) There is created the Suggestion Team Arkansas Award Board.		
7	(2) The membership of the board shall consist of the Director of		
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, the Personnel Director, who		
9	shall serve as chair, and the cochairs of the Legislative Council, and the		
10	cochairs of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee.		
11	(b) Regarding an employee suggestion made under this chapter, the		
12	board shall:		
13	(1) Review state agency findings and recommendations;		
14	(2) Evaluate the employee suggestion, taking into consideration		
15	state agency action and staff recommendations; and		
16	(3)(A) Determine whether to make an award to the employee or to		
17	each employee in the group of employees who made the employee suggestion.		
18	(B) If the board finds that more information is needed		
19	before determining whether to make an award, the board may delay making the		
20	determination until the information has been obtained.		
21	$\frac{(b)(c)}{(c)}$ The decisions of the board regarding suggestions, awards, and		
22	appeals shall be final and binding to all parties concerned.		
23	(c)(1) The board will review suggestions after the suggestor has		
24	filed a formal appeal.		
25	$\frac{(2)}{(d)}$ If, in the opinion of the board, further evaluation is		
26	needed, the board may request the $\underline{\text{state}}$ agency to reevaluate the suggestion.

28	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 21-11-107 is amended to read as follows:		
29	21-11-107. Awards for employee suggestions.		
30	(a)(1)(A) Any monetary award granted for a suggestion which may		
31	improve the economy and efficiency of state government shall be the greater		
32	of one hundred dollars (\$100) or ten percent (10%) of the amount of savings.		
33	(B) However, the monetary award shall be limited to a		
34	maximum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) unless a larger award is		
35	recommended by resolution of the General Assembly.		
36	(2) If an employee's suggestion appears to be one which may		

- 1 improve the economy and efficiency of state government but would require
- 2 legislative enactment, the suggestor shall receive a monetary award as
- 3 prescribed in subsection (a) of this section based on the actual net savings
- 4 after the end of the first year following implementation of the suggestion.
- 5 (a)(1) An award under this chapter shall not exceed ten percent (10%)
- 6 of the amount of an actual savings to the state in the first full fiscal year
- 7 <u>after an employee's suggestion is adopted.</u>
- 8 (2) As used in this section, "actual savings" includes the
- 9 <u>actual reduction</u>, elimination, or avoidance of expenditures or the
- 10 <u>improvement in operations reported under § 21-11-110.</u>
- 11 (b)(1) If an is award made to each employee in a group of employees
- 12 who made the employee suggestion, the head of the state agency that is the
- 13 <u>employer of the group of state employees shall determine the share of the</u>
- 14 award to be distributed to each employee in the group.
- 15 (2) The shares under subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall be
- 16 proportionate, fair, and equitable based on the contributions by each
- 17 employee to the employee suggestion.
- 18 (b)(c) When implementation of a suggestion an employee suggestion
- 19 would not result in cost reduction or avoidance but would visibly improve the
- 20 operations of a process or program or improve public relations, safety, or
- 21 effectiveness of operations as indicated in § 21-11-103, recognition of the
- 22 suggestor employee or each employee in the group of employees who made the
- 23 employee suggestion will be made by the issuance of a suitable certificate
- 24 and a monetary award of one hundred dollars (\$100).

- 26 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 21-11-108 is amended to read as follows:
- 27 21-11-108. Payment of awards.
- 28 (a) When it is determined by the Personnel Director Team Arkansas
- 29 Award Board that a monetary award is to be made under the rules of the
- 30 Employee Suggestion Team Arkansas System, he or she the board shall certify
- 31 the amount to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
- 32 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall cause a transfer to be
- 33 made of the amount of moneys awarded from the fund from which the benefiting
- 34 employee is being paid to the State Central Services Fund.
- 35 (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Treasurer of
- 36 State shall issue warrants to employees for approved employee suggestions in

3	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 21-11-109 is amended to read as follows:
4	21-11-109. Funding.
5	(a) No agency, board, or commission shall receive additional
6	appropriations or funds to carry out this chapter except the Office of
7	Personnel Management of the Division of Management Services of the Department
8	of Finance and Administration, which shall be allocated funds and
9	appropriations to administer it.
10	(b) All monetary awards prescribed in under § 21-11-107(a) or (b)
11	shall be made from the amount of appropriated money saved by the suggestions
12	of employees employee suggestions.
13	(c) The minimum monetary award prescribed in § 21-11-107 (b) (c) shall
14	be made from the agency's existing appropriation for the general maintenance
15	and operation of the agency.
16	
17	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 11, is amended to add a new
18	section to read as follows:
19	21-11-110 Report of state agency savings.
20	(a) A state agency that has adopted an employee suggestion under this
21	chapter shall report an actual reduction, elimination, or avoidance of
22	expenditures or improvement in operations made possible by the employee
23	suggestion.
24	(b) The report required under subsection (a) of this section shall be
25	made not later than thirty (30) day after the end:
26	(1) Of the fiscal year during which the employee suggestion was
27	adopted; and
28	(2) Of any subsequent fiscal year during which the state agency
29	realizes any actual reduction, elimination, or avoidance of expenditures or
30	improvement in operations made possible by the employee suggestion.
