For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO ADDRESS THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT A CITY
9 OR TOWN DERIVES FROM TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING
10 SPEED LIMIT VIOLATIONS, ISSUED ON FEDERAL HIGHWAYS
11 WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS; TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF
12 REVENUE THAT A CITY OR TOWN CAN RECEIVE FROM SPEED
13 LIMIT VIOLATIONS AND REQUIRE MONEYS IN EXCESS OF THAT
14 LIMIT TO BE USED FOR FEDERAL HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE BY
15 THE STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
28

29 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to:

30 (1) Address the amount of revenue that a city or town derives
31 from traffic violations, including speed limit violations, issued on federal
32 highways within the jurisdictional limits of the city or town;

33 (2) Limit the amount of revenue that a city or town can receive
34 from speed limit violations; and

35 (3) Require moneys in excess of that limit to be used for
36 federal highway maintenance by the state.
