11 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HERITAGE 13 AND MUSEUM SITES FUNDING. Any additional funds received by ASU - Jonesboro 14 may be utilized to fund the appropriation authorized for Hemingway-Pfeifer 15 House, Tenant Farmers Museum, Lakeport Plantation, and the Heritage Center 16 expenses.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 18 2011 2012 through June 30, 2012 2013.

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20 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the president or chancellor 23 of an institution of higher education that a reallocation of resources for 24 purposes of reorganization or consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary for efficient and effective operations of 25 26 the institution, the president or chancellor, with approval of the 27 institution's board of trustees, may have the authority to transfer 28 positions, appropriations and related funds between campuses, divisions, 29 branches, and other budgetary units of the institution, after receiving prior 30 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. The transfers 31 of positions, programs, or activities shall be used for those purposes for 32 which the appropriations were approved by the General Assembly. The 33 transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve academic programs 34 shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education prior to submission 35 to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Provided, however, that 36 the institution shall be limited to submitting no more than two (2)

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1 individual transaction transfer requests during any fiscal year and shall be 2 further limited to no more than five percent (5%) of the total General 3 Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, positions specific to 4 each institution and no Tobacco Settlement funds or appropriations may be 5 reallocated pursuant to this section. 6 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 7 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher 8 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This

9 is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation 10 act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue 11 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the 12 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that 13 institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some 14 flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad 15 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate 16 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of 17 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this 18 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 19 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement 20 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 21 22 void.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,

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26 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEASES. 28 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Board of Trustees of Arkansas 29 State University may hereafter lease facilities for operations for room and board purposes for students only in any manner and upon terms the board deems 30 31 to be in the best interest of the university. Action taken under this act 32 shall be by written resolution adopted by at least a majority of the members 33 of the board.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2011 2012 through June 30, 2012 2013.

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1 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 3 4 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 7 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 8 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 9 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 10 with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 12 13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 20

SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 21 22 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 23 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of 25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 26 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm 28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012. 31 32 33 34

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
