## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STUDY OF  
9 BENEFITS OF LIGNITE INFUSED POULTRY WATER FOR THE  
10 UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS - POULTRY SCIENCE  
11 DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,  
12 2013; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -  
16 POULTRY SCIENCE DEPARTMENT - STUDY OF  
17 BENEFITS OF LIGNITE INFUSED POULTRY WATER  
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2012-2013 FISCAL  
19 YEAR.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - LIGNITE INFUSED POULTRY WATER STUDY. There  
26 is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the  
27 University of Arkansas Fund, for personal services, operating expenses,  
28 supplies, and equipment for the study of benefits of giving lignite infused  
29 water to poultry, of the University of Arkansas – Poultry Science Department  
30 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the sum of.....\$20,000.  
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32 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
34 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the passage and approval of this Act, the Chief  
35 Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the  
36 State Treasurer and the Auditor of State the sum of twenty thousand dollars



1 (\$20,000) or so much thereof as is available from the unobligated balance in  
 2 the General Improvement Fund to the University of Arkansas Fund to provide  
 3 funds for the purposes and appropriation provided in Section 1 of this Act.  
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5 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 6 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 7 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 8 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 11 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 12 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 13 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 14 with in disbursement of said funds.  
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16 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 18 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 19 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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25 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012, with the exception that Section 2  
 29 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
 30 passage and approval, is essential to the operation of the agency for which  
 31 the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an  
 32 extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this  
 33 Act beyond July 1, 2012, with the exception that Section 2 in this Act shall  
 34 be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and  
 35 approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
 36 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is

1 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate  
2 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force  
3 and effect from and after July 1, 2012, with the exception that Section 2 in  
4 this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
5 passage and approval.

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
