11 JUNE 30, 2019; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE PROSECUTOR  
15 COORDINATOR APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2018-  
16 2019 FISCAL YEAR.

18  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator for the 2018-2019 fiscal year,  
24 the following maximum number of regular employees.

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5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 6 to the Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator, to be payable from the State  
 7 Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 8 Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
 9 2019, the following:

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23 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PROSECUTORIAL PROGRAMS.  
 24 There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator, to  
 25 be payable from the Law Enforcement and Prosecutor Drug Enforcement Training  
 26 Fund, for Law Enforcement and Prosecutor Drug Enforcement Training by the  
 27 Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
 28 2019, the following:

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35 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,  
19 2018.
