 30 authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Trial Public
 31 Defender Office for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the following maximum number
 32 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable
 33 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or

28 SECTION 10. EXTRA HELP - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. There is
 29 hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission for the 2020-
 30 2021 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 31 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 32 herein for such purposes: fourteen (14) temporary or part-time employees,
 33 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 34 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 35 appropriate classification.

SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INDIGENT PARENT COUNSEL REPRESENTATION. The Commission for Parent Counsel shall have the authority to use the appropriation provided in line item Parent Counsel Reimbursements of the Parent Counsel Program appropriation herein for the purpose of entering into independent professional service contracts on a full-time or part-time basis with attorneys who are qualified to provide counsel for indigent parents in dependency-neglect cases.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~ 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION – LINE ITEMS - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the

1 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
2 Arkansas Public Defender Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation,
3 with the exception of Personal Services Matching, between the line items
4 authorized herein for the Commission for Parent Counsel, to best utilize
5 resources to meet the needs of the Parent Counsel's clientele.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
7 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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9 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE
10 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
11 EXTRA HELP EXEMPTION - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. Extra Help positions
12 authorized herein for the Commission for Parent Counsel are specifically
13 exempt from limitation of hours. Employees currently working on a part-time
14 basis may be utilized concurrently as Extra Help within the agency. The
15 total amount of compensation for part-time and Extra Help work combined
16 cannot exceed the maximum compensation allowed for a grade GS11 as authorized
17 in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. Flexibility is needed to
18 allow for non-traditional work schedules that may be necessary to accommodate
19 the schedule of the individual being represented. Attorneys utilized as
20 Extra Help employees are not prevented from having other employment.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
22 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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24 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
26 PROVISION. If the Public Defender Commission should determine that the
27 appropriations made available for payments to the Counties are insufficient,
28 appropriation may be transferred from the Public Defender Commission Program
29 line item to the Bail Bond-County Public Defender line item, after receiving
30 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2019~~
32 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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34 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC
36 DEFENDERS. (a) No funds appropriated herein shall be used for expenses in

1 cases where a defendant is represented by retained counsel where retained
2 counsel have not gone through the Public Defender Commission's attorney
3 certification procedure and designation process as established by state law
4 and the Commission's regulations. All defendants and retained attorneys must
5 strictly adhere to the procedure established by the Commission to equitably
6 and responsibly monitor and distribute State funds for this purpose.

7 (b) The Public Defender Commission may approve exemptions to subsection
8 (a) as needed. Reasons for granting exemption should be specified in writing.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019
10 2020 through June 30, ~~2020~~ 2021.

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12 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
13 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
15 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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22 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
24 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
25 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
32 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
33 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
36 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.

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
