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19 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for 20 the Department of Commerce - Division of State Services for the Blind for the 21 2020-2021 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary 22 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated 23 herein for such purposes: thirty (30) temporary or part-time employees, when 24 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform 25 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the 26 appropriate classification.

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28 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, 29 to the Department of Commerce, to be payable from the State Services for the 30 Blind Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of 31 Commerce - State Services for the Blind for the fiscal year ending June 30, 32 2021, the following:

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12 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 14 COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. The Rehabilitation Act 15 Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to as the Comprehensive System of 16 Personnel Development (CSPD), requires State Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) 17 agencies to establish qualified personnel standards for rehabilitation 18 personnel, including Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors, that are 19 consistent with any national or State-approved or recognized certification, 20 licensing, or registration that apply to a particular profession. In order 21 to comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there 22 is hereby authorized for the Department of Commerce, Division of State 23 Services for the Blind a general waiver of the Financial Management Guide, 24 R1-19-4-522 Continuing Professional Education. This waiver allows the agency 25 to provide college level coursework in degree programs for any eligible 26 employees selected by the agency. This provision covers any and all formula 27 and discretionary grants funded by the U.S. Department of Education 28 Rehabilitation Services Administration, now or in the future, including, but 29 not limited to, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program, Supported Employment, 30 Independent Living, and the Staff Development Grant. No state general 31 revenue shall be expended for the tuition in pursuit of a degree authorized 32 herein. 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 34 2020 through June 30, 2020 2021. 35

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 19-5-

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1 306(8), concerning the Department of Human Services Fund, is repealed. 2 (8) State Services for the Blind Fund Account. 3 (A) The State Services for the Blind Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the Division of State 4 5 Services for the Blind in carrying out the powers, functions, and duties as 6 set out in § 25-10-201 et seq. or other duties imposed by law upon the 7 Division of State Services for the Blind. 8 (B) The State Services for the Blind Fund Account shall consist of: 9 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by programs of 10 the Division of State Services for the Blind; and 11 12 (iii) Any other nonfederal grants funds provided by law; 13 14 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 19, 15 Chapter 5, Subchapter 3, is amended to add an additional section to read as 16 follows: 17 19-5-312. State Services for the Blind Fund. 18 (a) The State Services for the Blind Fund shall be used for the 19 maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the Division of State 20 Services for the Blind in carrying out the powers, functions, and duties as set out in § 25-10-201 et seq. or other duties imposed by law upon the 21 22 division. 23 (b) The State Services for the Blind Fund shall consist of: (1) Those general revenues provided by law; 24 25 (2) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by programs of 26 the division; and 27 (3) Any other nonfederal grants funds provided by law. 28 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CODE 30 AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 25-10-201(b), concerning the public policy 31 32 related to the Division of State Services for the Blind, is amended to read 33 as follows: 34 (b) The General Assembly finds that this purpose may be best accomplished by the establishment of a Division of State Services for the 35

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Blind within the Department of Human Services Commerce with the necessary

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authority to administer the services and programs for the blind and visually
impaired.

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4 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 7 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 14 15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 22

23 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 24 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 25 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm 29 30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 31 32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 33 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020. 34 35 APPROVED: 4/20/20

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
