9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE PAROLE BOARD FOR THE
10 FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE PAROLE BOARD APPROPRIATION
15 FOR THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
22 Parole Board for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum number of
23 regular employees.

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6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
7 to the Parole Board, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund
8 Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Parole Board for
9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

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23 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
25 ASSISTANCE PROVISION. The Department of Correction and the Department of
26 Community Correction may provide services, furnishings, equipment and office
27 space to assist the Parole Board in fulfilling the purposes for which the
28 Board was created by law.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
30 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~2017.

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32 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING
34 REQUIREMENTS. (a) The Parole Board shall submit annually to the Joint
35 Performance Review Committee, the Senate Committee on Judiciary, and the
36 House Committee on Judiciary a copy of the board's rules and policies,

1 including any Administrative Rules, Directives, Memoranda, and Operational
2 Policies, as well as any document intended to supplement any rule or policy;

3 (b) Emergency Preparedness Plans shall be excluded from the provisions
4 in this section.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
6 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~2017.

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8 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

1 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
