SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

15 AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION
16 CONCERNING THE POWER OF THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY TO ENACT CERTAIN LAWS PERTAINING
18 TO THE JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
22 OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
23 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

25 That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
26 the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
27 for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
28 and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
29 adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
30 the State of Arkansas, to wit:

32 SECTION 1. The purpose of this resolution is to amend the Arkansas
33 Constitution concerning the power of the General Assembly to enact certain
34 laws pertaining to the judicial department of government.
