A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A SINGLE ANNUAL FLEET OVERWEIGHT PERMIT FOR A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE FLEET THAT INCLUDES BOTH VEHICLES THAT HAVE A QUAD AXLE GROUPING AND VEHICLE COMBINATIONS WITH A TRAILER THAT HAS TWO OR THREE AXLES.

Bill Summary

Transportation Legislation Review Committee. Current law requires a commercial motor vehicle fleet owner that wishes to apply for an annual fleet overweight permit to apply for separate annual fleet

permits for vehicles that have a quad axle grouping for divisible vehicles or loads, and vehicle combinations with a trailer that have 2 or 3 axles for divisible vehicles or loads. The bill allows a fleet owner that has a fleet consisting of vehicles from both of these categories to apply for a single annual fleet overweight permit.
