1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** Legislative declaration. The general assembly 3 declares that the purpose of this act is to repeal obsolete statutory 4 provisions relating to the Colorado department of public health and 5 environment. The general assembly further declares that repealing these 6 statutory provisions does not alter the scope or applicability of the 7 remaining statutes. 8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1-108, repeal 9 (1)(h) as follows: 10 25-1-108. Powers and duties of state board of health. (1) In 11 addition to all other powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the 12 state board of health by the provisions of this part 1, the board has the 13 following specific powers and duties: 14 (h) To comply with the requirements of section 24-1-136.5, 15 C.R.S., concerning the preparation of operational master plans, facilities 16 master plans, and facilities program plans, as if the state board of health 17 were the executive director of the department. 18 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 19 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 20 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 21 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a 22 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 23 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act

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- within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
- 2 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
- November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 4 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
